### I-95 LANE CLOSURES

- FRIDAY, JULY 12 THROUGH MONDAY, JULY 15 - Two southbound, I-95 lanes will be **continuously closed** from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street starting at 11 p.m. on Friday, July 12, until 5:30 a.m. on Monday, July 15. One additional southbound lane from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. and on Sunday between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

### I-95 RAMP CLOSURES TO EASTBOUND I-395

- SATURDAY, JULY 13, SUNDAY, JULY 14 AND MONDAY, JULY 15 - The southbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Saturday and between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. on Sunday and Monday. Drivers can:
  - Continue south on I-95, exit at the NW 8 Street (Exit 3B)
  - Turn left on NW 8 Street, continue east on NW 8 Street
  - Turn left at Biscayne Boulevard to access the A1A North/Miami Beach Ramp
  - NOTE: I-195 can also be used as an alternate route to access Miami Beach

- SATURDAY, JULY 13, SUNDAY, JULY 14 AND MONDAY, JULY 15 - The northbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Saturday and between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. on Sunday and Monday. Drivers can:
  - Exit at the NW 2 Street ramp (Exit 2B)
  - Continue north on NW 3 Avenue, then turn right on NW 8 Street
  - Continue east on NW/NE 8 Street
  - Turn left on Biscayne Boulevard to access A1A North/Miami Beach
  - NOTE: I-195 can also be used as an alternate route to access Miami Beach

## EASTBOUND SR 836 RAMP TO NORTHBOUND I-95

- SUNDAY, JULY 14 AND MONDAY, JULY 15 - The eastbound SR 836 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Continue east on I-395
  - Exit at NE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2A)
  - Continue past NE 2 Avenue, use U-turn before Biscayne Boulevard to access west I-395 west
  - Continue west on NE 12 Street to access I-95 north

## THE FOLLOWING CLOSURES ARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE I-95 PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FROM NW 29 STREET TO NW 79 STREET

- FRIDAY, JULY 12 AND SATURDAY, JULY 13 - All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 AND SATURDAY, JULY 13 - Two southbound, general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 79 Street to NW 46 Street on Friday and Saturday between the hours 11 p.m. to 11 a.m.
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 THROUGH MONDAY, JULY 15 - Two northbound, I-95 lanes will be **continuously closed** from NW 24 Street to NW 53 Street, starting at 11 p.m. on Friday, July 12, until 6 a.m. on Monday, July 15. Only one northbound, general-purpose lane will be open between 11 p.m. and 9 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

- FRIDAY, JULY 12, SATURDAY, JULY 13 AND SUNDAY, JULY 14 - One northbound 95 Express Lane will be closed from the entrance to NW 53 Street on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m., and on Sunday between the hours of 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 - There will be a full closure of NW 36 Street, from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue, on Friday between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on the ramps over the roadways. Drivers should follow the posted detour signs.
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 - The southbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 112 will be closed on Friday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Continue south on I-95, then exit at NW 8 Street, then turn left on NW 8 Street
  - Turn left on NW 3 Avenue to access I-95 north
  - Continue north on I-95 to access the SR 112 ramp
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 AND SATURDAY, JULY 13 - The NW 62 Street ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Go north on NW 7 Avenue
  - Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp
- FRIDAY, JULY 12 AND SATURDAY, JULY 13 - The northbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 62 Street will be closed on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Exit at NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street, then make a left at NW 81 Street
  - Turn left at NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 62 Street
- SATURDAY, JULY 13 - The westbound I-95 and eastbound SR 112 ramps to northbound I-95 will be closed on Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Go south on I-95, exit at NW 8 Street, then turn left on NW 8 Street
  - Turn left on NW 3 Avenue to access I-95 north

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**

The work is part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
