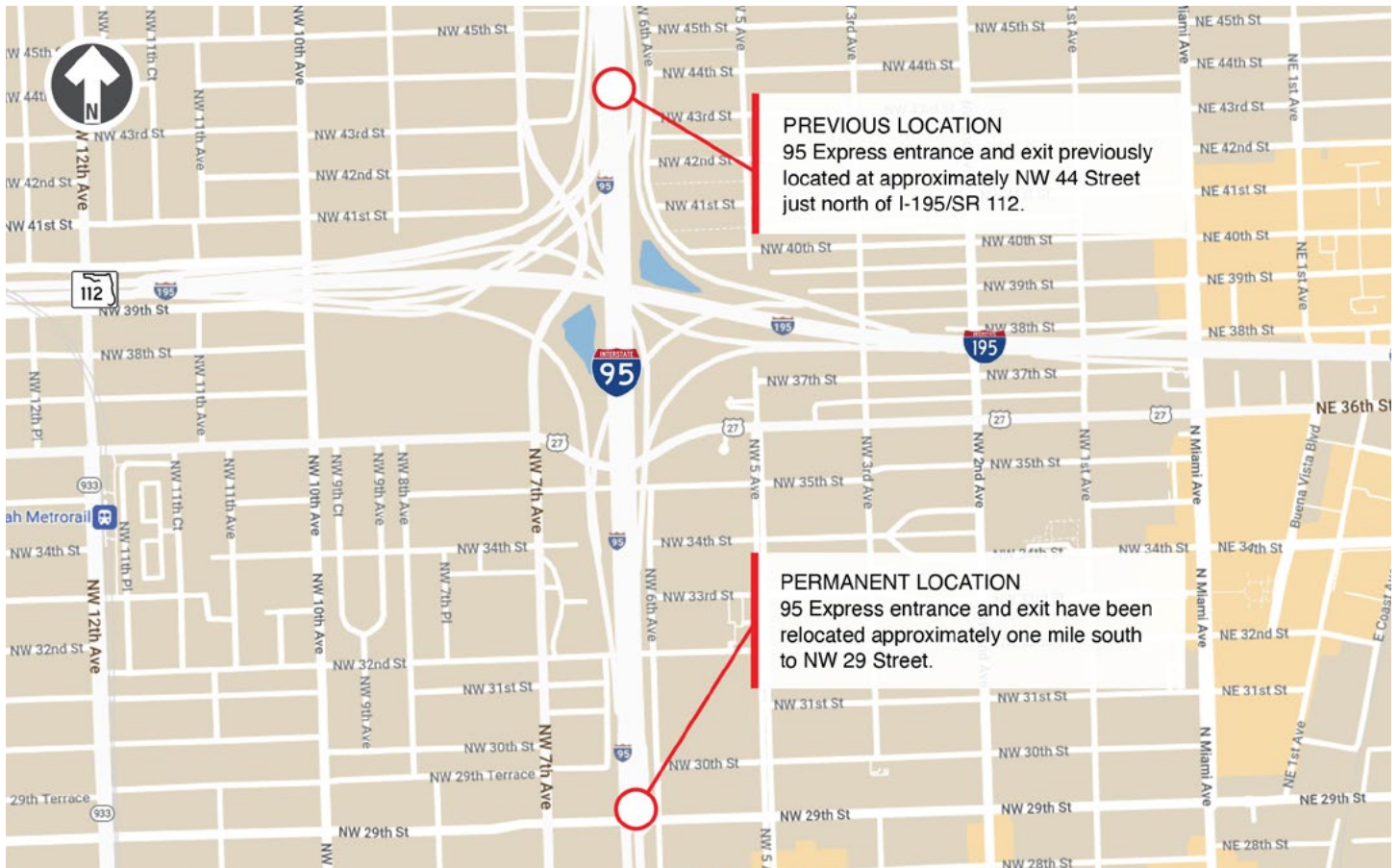


# I-395/SR 836/I-95 DESIGN-BUILD PROJECT

## RELOCATION OF 95 EXPRESS NORTHBOUND ENTRANCE AND SOUTHBOUND EXIT



The entrance and exit points to 95 Express have been shifted back to their original and permanent location, approximately one mile south to NW 29 Street on Interstate 95 (I-95) near Downtown Miami, as shown above.

The roadway lane striping, and overhead signage have been modified to reflect the permanent location of the 95 Express entrance and exit points. The placement of the plastic poles will be scheduled as noted below:

## Southbound 95 Express Lanes:

- Installation of the plastic poles on the southbound 95 Express Lanes will begin on **SUNDAY, APRIL 2**, at the north end and move south every night until all poles have been installed to NW 29 Street on approximately **THURSDAY MORNING, APRIL 6**. To complete the pole installation, the following closures will be implemented:
  - **SUNDAY, APRIL 2 THROUGH WEDNESDAY, APRIL 5** - All southbound 95 Express lanes will be closed from the Golden Glades Interchange to I-195/SR 112 between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
  - **SUNDAY, APRIL 2 THROUGH WEDNESDAY, APRIL 5** - One southbound general purpose lane from north of I-195/SR 112 to south of NW 29 Street will be closed between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

## Northbound 95 Express Lanes:

- Installation of the plastic poles on the northbound 95 Express Lanes will begin on **SUNDAY, APRIL 9**, at the north end and move south every night until all poles have been installed to NW 29 Street on approximately **THURSDAY MORNING, APRIL 13**. To complete the pole installation, the following closures will be implemented:
  - **SUNDAY, APRIL 9 THROUGH WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12** - All northbound 95 Express lanes will be closed from I-195/SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
  - **SUNDAY, APRIL 9 THROUGH WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12** - One northbound general purpose lane from north of I-195/SR 112 to south of NW 29 Street will be closed between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

## NORTHBOUND I-95 RAMP TO WESTBOUND SR 836 DETOUR

- **THURSDAY, MARCH 30** - The northbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
  - Enter the eastbound I-395 ramp
  - Exit at NE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2B), then turn right on NE 2 Avenue
  - Turn right on NE 11 Street
  - Turn right on NE 1 Avenue to access westbound I-395 to continue onto westbound SR 836

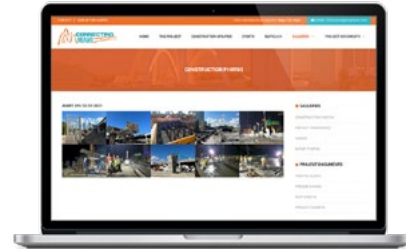

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**

The work is part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
